

## June 19th Meeting at Baltic

The June 19th meeting of COTOS will be held at the residence of Dorothy Steiner in Baltic, Ohio. Dorothy has a 3/16 Wurlitzer, which has been built up over the years from a smaller original instrument, Wurlitzer Opus 1684, a Style B. Also featured are a Conn and Hammond organ, and a collection of antique cars. The meeting will begin at 3 PM. Covered dishes and finger foods are also welcomed.

**Directions:** From Columbus: Take Interstate 70 EAST to I-77 (Cambridge, Oh). Go North onto I-77 to Newcomerstown (St Rte. 36). Exit WEST onto Route 36 and go about 11 miles, where you with turn right (North) Onto Route 93. From this point it is about another 11 miles to Baltic, OH. Turn Right at the flashing light, which is MAIN STREET in Baltic. This is also CR46 as you head out of town. You will go over a hill, and there will be a schoolhouse on the left. The next house on the left is Mrs. Steiner's. Proceed past her dirveway to the next drive, which is the parking lot.
