SUBJECT: REPLACEMENT OF MANUAL CONTACT SWITCH ARM

## TO REMOVE SWITCH ARM:

- 1. Follow procedure in Service Manual for removal of Playing Manual.
- 2. Remove switch arm eyelet from key lever.
- 3. Using an  $\frac{\#18}{}$  gauge wire (found on 1 watt resistors), force each contact spring out of switch arm. Do not bend or stretch spring.

## TO REASSEMBLE:

1. Use four  $\frac{\#20}{2}$  gauge wires (found on  $\frac{1}{2}$  watt resistors), insert wires through the proper holes in the switch arm and into the contact springs (see drawing below).

NOTE: The above procedure is for alignment purposes and also to keep the springs from bending.

- 2. Force the switch arm down on the contact springs. The springs should come flush with the top of the arm.
- 3. Snap eyelet back on key lever and replace Playing Manual in instrument.
