## **BOZ SCAGGS:**Out of The Blues Tour 2021

It's appropriate that Boz Scaggs' latest album is *Out of the Blues*, since the blues is what sparked his five-decade musical career.

After first spending several years as a journeyman musician around Madison, WI, and Austin, TX, a young Boz Scaggs spent time traveling Europe, the Middle East, and Asia, eventually settling in Stockholm where he recorded the album *Boz*.

Returning to the U.S. in '67, Mr. Scaggs joined the Steve Miller Band before launching his solo career with 1968's seminal *Boz Scaggs*. He continued to mine a personalized mix of rock, blues and R&B influences, along with a signature style on influential '70s albums like *Moments*, *Boz Scaggs & Band, My Time, Slow Dancer*, and 1976's *Silk Degrees*. The latter record became a massive commercial breakthrough, remaining on the album charts for 115 weeks. It spawned three Top 40 hit singles: "It's Over", "Lido Shuffle", and the Grammy-winning "Lowdown".



More recently, Boz returned to the studio to release *Other Roads*, *Some Change*, *Dig*, the Grammy-nominated *Come on Home*, the unplugged *Fade Into Light*, and the in-concert retrospective *Greatest Hits Live*. His popular recording of jazz standards, *Speak Low*, topped the Billboard Jazz chart and wasfollowed by the Southern-flavored Memphis and the rhythm & bluesy *A Fool to Care*.



Fresh off the release of Nate Bargatze's highly anticipated second Netflix special "The Greatest Average American," now streaming worldwide on Netflix, "The Raincheck Tour" will feature all new material.

Off-screen, Nate was part of "Jimmy Fallon's Clean-Cut Comedy Tour," and has done live shows for the troops in Iraq and Kuwait five times. In addition to touring the country as a headliner, Nate toured in arenas with Chris Rock on his 2017 "Total Blackout Tour." He regularly performs at Bonnaroo, SXSW, Oddball Comedy Festival, Sasquatch, Clusterfest, and the JFL Montreal Comedy Festival, where he's received critical acclaim multiple years in a row.

The Champaign-Urbana Theatre Company (CUTC), started in the fall of 1991 with a single meeting of ten local theater-buffs. At the time, the historic Virginia Theatre in downtown Champaign, Illinois, was in danger of being lost, and this core group wanted to preserve the facility while also fostering community theater. As a result of this meeting, the Champaign-Urbana Theatre Company was founded and incorporated as a non-profit organization. By 2004, an estimated 530 volunteers took part on stage or behind the scenes, and over 11,000 community members attended their productions.

## GLENN MILLER ORCHESTRA HOLIDAY CONCERT!

The legendary Glenn Miller was one of the most successful of all dance bandleaders back in the Swing Era of the 1930s and 40s, with a matchless string of hit records such as his signature "In The Mood". Glenn disbanded the group in 1942 to volunteer for the Army, forming his famous Glenn Miller Army Air Force Band. On December 15, 1944, Major Miller took off in a single engine plane, disappearing over the English Channel, never to be seen again.

In 1956, with the full permission of the Miller estate, the reformed Glenn Miller Orchestra performed its first concert and has been on the road ever since.



Today, the 18-member ensemble continues to play the original Miller arrangements both from the civilian band and the AAFB libraries. Just as it was in Glenn's day, the Glenn Miller Orchestra of today is still the most sought after big band in the world!

## **THE BAT**A Mystery Drama in Three Acts

On December 28, 1921, the front doors of an ornate, 1,900-seat venue were opened to the public for the very first time. The name of this new performance space and movie palace was The Virginia Theatre.

That evening, before a sold-out house, The Virginia proudly presented a touring production of the stage play *The Bat*. A comedy-mystery that helped inspire the original Batman comics of the 1930s, *The Bat* was a hit on Broadway, running for 867 performances in New York and

another 327 performances in London, with six different road companies ultimately taking the show on the road to communities like Champaign.



The Bat was drawn from Mary Roberts Rinehart's famous story, The Circular Staircase, and was set for the stage by Rinehart and her collaborator Avery Hopwood.

Sun Ra Arkestra is the name of the current incarnation of Sun Ra's original jazz band, now led by Marshall Allen. A member of the band since 1958, Allen became the leading force and core of the Arkestra after Sun Ra's death in 1993. Carrying out Sun Ra's vision through the ensemble, Allen directs fifteen musicians at a time, keeping with the Arkestra's big-band traditionalism.

For much of his career, Sun Ra led the Arkestra—an ensemble with an ever-changing and flexible line-up. The legendary Sun Ra, born Herman Poole Blount in Alabama in 1914, was a jazz composer



and improvisor, bandleader, visionary piano and synthesizer player, performance artist and poet known for his cutting-edge sound, cosmic philosophy, and avant-garde theatrical performances.

#### **PRIVACY POLICY**

The Champaign Park District (Park District), as owner of the Virginia Theatre, is committed to maintaining online privacy. The Park District's Online Privacy Policy applies to data collected for the Park District, including the Virginia Theatre. The Park District does not collect personal information without permission.

Personal information that is collected, such as name, address, telephone number, and other non-protected data are private and cannot be given to the general public, including third parties, for direct correspondence or advertising purposes. The Park District utilizes this information for the processing of ticket sales for programs and events at the Virginia Theatre and in order to contact you, if necessary. If such information is not provided, you may not be able to purchase tickets for Virginia Theatre programs or events.

The information you provide may be released to: persons authorized to have access to the information under state or federal law; persons authorized by court order to have access to the information; persons to whom you have given written consent to have access to the information; and all individuals employed by or permitted under contract with the Park District who have a need to know the information in order to administer, manage, and improve Park District programming, administration, and operations. At any time, you may request that your online Virginia Theatre patron account be deactivated, and we will comply with your request. Historical transactions may be retained by the Park District for audit and archival purposes.

# INFORMATION GATHERING AND COOKIES

A cookie is a very small test file inserted onto your computer by a website that a person visits. When a user returns to the website, the cookie is then read by the site's web server. Cookies are used for many things, from making websites more personal to tracking your web browsing habits.

Visitors to the Virginia Theatre website can read or download information, such as schedules, forms, or brochures from the website. The Park District obtains and stores only the domain name of the website visitor's computer (for example, gmail. com), its browser type and version, and other related information to speed up the future performance of webpage delivery. All information is deleted from the website visitor's cache memory when closing the session and leaving the site. The Park District collects no other personal information.

The Park District uses Google Analytics and Google AdWords for this purpose, and those services are in place on the Virginia Theatre website in order to learn more about our visitors and customers. The Park District and Virginia Theatre do not rent, sell, or share personal information about you with other people or nonaffiliated companies except to provide products or services you have requested. We may provide the information to trusted partners who work on behalf of or with the Park District or Virginia Theatre. Those entities or individuals may use information in the normal course of offering events, programs, or activities. However, those companies do not have any independent right to share such information. The Park District may use such information to respond to subpoenas, court orders, legal process or requests. or establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against claims; or if we believe it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent, or act regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, violations of Park District ordinances or policies, or as otherwise required by law.

#### **ADMISSION POLICIES**

Tickets are required for all ages, for all shows. One admission per ticket. Infant comp tickets may be made available to the public at select performances; please inquire with the Box Office prior to ordering tickets. Each show's presenter will determine age restrictions for entry, if applicable.

If your tickets are waiting for you at Will Call, please bring a photo ID with you.

In some cases, latecomers will be seated at the discretion of the production.

No cameras or recording devices allowed inside the theatre. Any exception to this policy will be announced at the performance as well as in-advance, when possible.

There is no outside food or drink allowed inside the Virginia Theatre at any time.

Smoking is strictly prohibited in the Virginia Theatre.

For everyone's safety, the Virginia Theatre inspects all bags upon entry of the theatre. Please allow extra time for this process.
